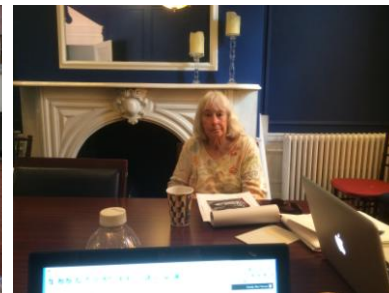

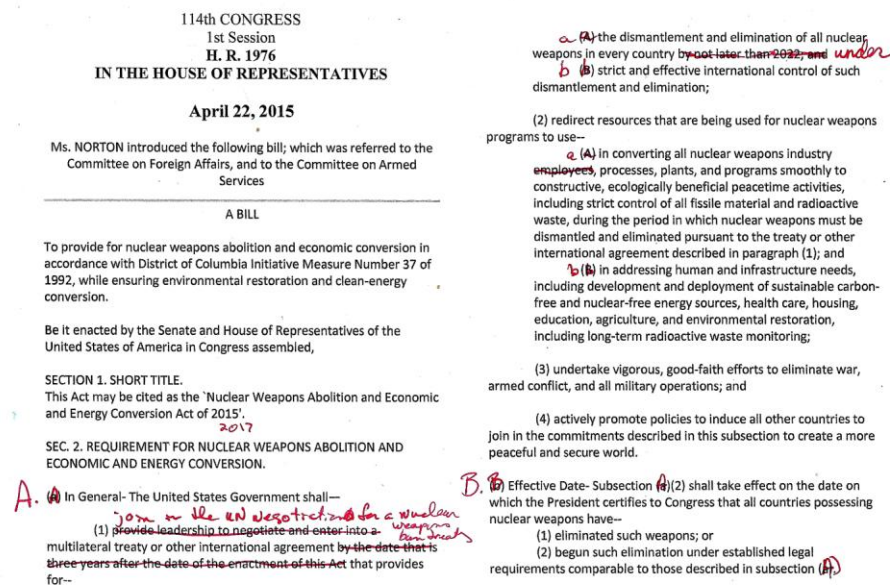
May 22 – evening - “Pizza Party” at Mott House



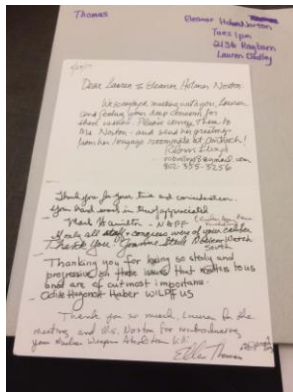
May 23 - Robin Lloyd and Odile Hugonot-Haber met with Medea Benjamin,

...and Representative Jan Schakowsky (Chicago), who met with us personally ...

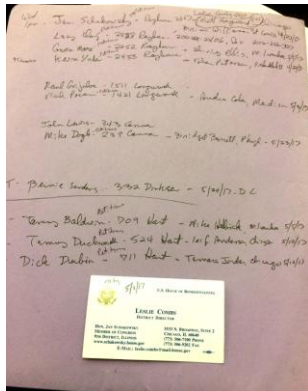


... and promised to co-sponsor [Congresswoman Norton's bill](#).
